

The Betty Hansen Memorial Scholarship Program

The Betty Hansen Memorial Scholarship Program was established by the Cuyahoga County Farm Bureau in 1992 to honor Betty Hansen for her leadership to the organization as a former president and board member of the Cuyahoga County Farm Bureau and her lifetime profession as a greenhouse farmer in Cuyahoga County. The objective of the scholarship program is to assist youth, who have been active in the Farm Bureau youth program and/or whose parents are Farm Bureau members, to continue their education in an agriculture-related field of study.

Scholarship Amount: Minimum \$250.00 Maximum \$1000.00

Qualifications of Applicant

1. Applicant (or parent of applicant) must be a Cuyahoga Farm Bureau member.
2. Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student in a two or four-year college or university program at an Ohio college or technical school, majoring in an agricultural study program.
3. Applicant must be continuing his/her education as an undergraduate or graduate student with an average to above-average scholarship standing.
4. Scholarship monies will be paid to the recipient.
5. Recipient may reapply annually (for a maximum of four years).

Selection

A three-member Scholarship Committee will select the recipients from the applications submitted.

Submitting Application

Request for applications can be made after March 1 each year. Deadline for submitted completed application is July 1st each year. The applications should be mailed or delivered to:
